

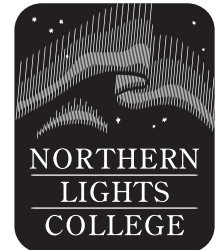

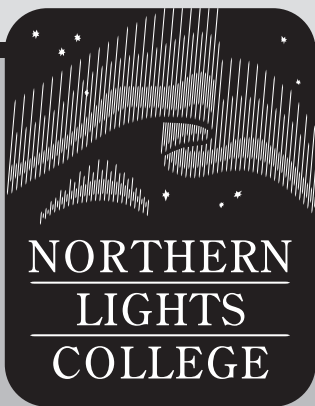

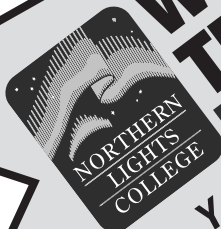

## **HOISTING AND RIGGING**

Wed-Sat 21-24 April

This course is directed to individuals who have responsibilities relating to the movement of material. This course applies to riggers, operators and those **"I only have to hook this one load, that's all"** employees.

Upon completion of this course the participants will be able to:

- \* Communicate with each other while moving and hoisting equipment, by using hand signals properly and uniformly
- \* Through knowledge and techniques gained during the course, safely pick up loads with confidence knowing how to estimate weights, know the correct derating factors necessary to identify Safe Working Load values and use of proper rigging for lifts big and small
- \* Develop and establish safe working practices while working around and in a hoisting and rigging environment

## **BOOM TRUCK OPERATOR**

Sun-Wed 25-28 April

This four-day course will certify a participant in Boom Truck Operating by ensuring the individual can explain and demonstrate competency in the following objectives (hands-on instruction included):

- \* Demonstrate a clear insight in evaluating dangers one must deal with while rigging a load to be lifted
- \* Demonstrate correct boom truck operating techniques prior to lifting a load
- \* Demonstrate safe operating techniques for the lifting and placing of the load
- \* Familiarity with WCB Regulation requirements
