In this Ends Policy, “Truth and Reconciliation” means the College’s strategic pillar whereby the College strives to work in partnership with Indigenous peoples and communities to advance reconciliation through true, lasting, and substantive participation.

The President shall pursue the improvement of the Truth and Reconciliation by pursuing the following strategic goals:

1. Acknowledge truths and build lasting relationships with Indigenous communities through consistent and accountable actions
2. Increase access to learning and education opportunities for Indigenous students
3. Co-create programming and training with Indigenous communities that centres Indigenous experiences, worldviews, methodologies, and processes
4. Strengthen Indigenous representation on campuses

The President shall provide the Board access to the College’s plans to pursue each strategic goal.
