2. The Board shall identify communities and organizations with which it requires good working relationships in order to achieve its Ends. It will establish mechanisms for maintaining open communication with these communities and organizations. Such mechanisms may include, but are not limited to:
  - 2.1 Gathering input from representatives of diverse communities and organizations.
  - 2.2 Meeting with other Boards on occasion.
  - 2.3 Honouring the principles of reconciliation in our relationship with Indigenous communities in the region.
