POLICY

The College may assist learners to obtain financial aid from the following sources, including Canada Student Loans, sponsorship through federal or provincial training programs and external agencies, or scholarships and bursaries.

The Northern Lights College Foundation administers scholarships and bursaries.

PROCEDURE

A student who does not have available the necessary funds for tuition and other related costs at the time of registration may receive financial assistance which will permit him/her to register.

The Student Services, Financial Aid Officer, or other designated person will assess the student's situation to determine which funding source may apply to this situation.

Students attending the College may also apply for scholarships and/or bursaries administered by the Northern Lights College Foundation.
